



THRESHOLD TO DISCONTINUE OPERATION OF THE 1022 CLUB IN HARTFORD

After several discussions amongst Threshold board members and several meetings with board members of the Medical Center Foundation of Hartford, it is with great sadness and deep regret that beginning April 1, 2021 the Threshold will no longer be in a position to operate The 1022 Club in Hartford.

The Threshold is developing a plan to provide services that continue to meet the needs of those we serve with cognitive and physical disabilities, developmental delays and traumatic brain injuries and to support long-term organizational sustainability. The plan will likely include a focus on core programming and facility consolidation resulting in a leaner, client-focused organization.

We understand how very important this service is to members and their families and to the community as a whole. Our wonderful staff have developed many caring relationships with 1022 Club members during our time of operation.

The Medical Center Foundation of Hartford is currently meeting with organizations who may have an interest in operating the Club in the same capacity. We will continue to work with the Medical Center Foundation of Hartford as they take their next steps.
